

#### Minutes General Membership Meeting April 27th, 2012

Meeting called to order by President Terry Reed at 6:35 P.M. There were a total of 17 members present and 5 additional member showed up late. All members introduced themselves.

President Terry Reed explained the new Hall of Fame Program; Regional Hall of Fame requiring 5 Regional Medals earned in 5 seasons and International Hall of Fame requiring 3 Championship Medals in 3 separate seasons. Adding if a dog earns a Championship medal in both Snow and Wheels the same season it is counted only as 1 earned for that season. Hall of Fame Certificates have been created and will be given to inductees. A plaque may be purchased at the owner/handlers expense.

Web Master Donna Daymude explained the Domain for the web site expires in either June or July 2012. We will need to renew the web site. The site is no longer with Web.com.

President Terry Reed opened the floor for members to voice any concerns or items they would like the Board of Directors to review at the upcoming board meeting. Sean Hammell brought up that members pulling in his area had asked about the delay in pull results being posted on the Web Site. It was explained by President Reed the dates of which after the pull results are mailed (within 5 days of the pull) the results are recorded into the Sanctioning data base. The Sanctioning Director must submit the pull results to the Newsletter Editor by the 18th of each month. At that same time the results are also submitted to the Web Master. Depending on the date of the pull the results may not get submitted to the Newsletter Editor and Web Master until the following month due to submission deadlines. President Terry Reed also reminded everyone that Committee Chair persons are all volunteers and many of the positions and tasks are very time consuming duties. President Terry Reed reminded everyone that the Newsletter is the Official Notification format to all members and the website is a convenience to members and a means of information for the public. Additionally Statistician Sue Ferrari explained she often receives pull results and she must interpret the dog/handlers as some handlers use several different names for the same dog; this slows down her process of data entry. It would help immensely if owner/handlers would use the same name and spelling for every pull they enter.

Sean Hammell also mentioned the difficulties and expense in submitting fee's in US Currency. Treasurer Cheryl Martin suggested possibly looking at other ways to submit fees that may help elevate costs in currency exchanges. She will research options and report back with results.

It was also discussed that several members had not received their Championship invitations prior to them leaving for Championships. It was asked if it would be possible to send Championship invitations via e-mail or at least a notification letter to the handlers who's dog/s earned an invitation to compete at the Championships. It was explained how Donna Libbey must verify each dog's eligibility and that process is very time consuming; which is why we ask owner/handlers to notify Donna when they know their dog/placing 4th or 5th place qualifies by beating a medalist so she can verify the eligibility.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting; motion second and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:11 P.M.

#### Royal's Mischievous Baron Baxter October 21, 2003 - May 2, 2012

Baron Baxter was laid to rest on May 2, 2012. Baxter suffered a stroke on April 22 and despite veterinary care and medications he never recovered and his condition continued to deteriorate. The decision was made to let him go with the dignity he so deserved.

Baxter came to Robbie and Terry Reed as a malnourished and neglected rescue at the age of 10 months old. Anyone that saw Robbie and Baxter in competition witnessed a very special bond.

Baxter loved to pull and he loved Robbie. Even with Hip Dysplasia he would pull all he could for Robbie. Terry often said that if Baxter had healthy hips he and King Dukes would not have had a chance against Baxter and Robbie.



Baxter retired after the 2011 Championships but he was not happy about it. When the gear was being loaded for the younger dogs he always thought he should be going too.

In his seven seasons of IWPA competition Baxter earned;

Baxter also won Bronze medals on Snow in the 150# class at the 2009 and 2010 Championships.



# International Weight Pull Association Working Dog Degree Program

Your dog must meet the criteria below to be eligible for the various working dog degrees. When your dog has achieved the required number of pulls for a degree (at an IWPA Sanctioned or IWPA Approved pull) and you have completed the application forms for each pull, send the forms and \$10 for each certificate requested to the Working Dog Chairperson, after September 1 in the following program year. Your certificate will be mailed to the address on the application form. Please complete all blanks on the forms to aid in the processing of the certificates. All pulls required for a certificate must be achieved in no more than two consecutive program years. The program year is from September 1 to August 31 the following year.

#### **Requirements for Certificates**

#### Snow

- 1. IWPA Working Dog: the dog must pull 5 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on snow.
- 2. IWPA Working Dog Excellent: the dog must pull 10 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on snow.
- 3. IWPA Working Dog Superior: the dog must pull 15 times its own body weight in 3 different pulls on snow.

#### Wheels

- 1. IWPA Working Dog: the dog must pull 12 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on wheels.
- 2. IWPA Working Dog Excellent: the dog must pull 18 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on wheels.
- 3. IWPA Working Dog Superior: the dog must pull 23 times its own body weight in 3 different pulls on wheels.
