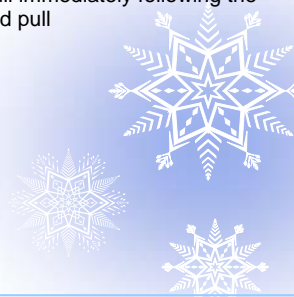

INTERNATIONAL WEIGHT PULL ASSOCIATION WEIGHT PULL STANDING RULES ON SANCTIONING

In order for your pull to be sanctioned and to count for points.

Any organization who wishes to put on a pull approved by the I.W.P.A. shall require the organizer or any of the officials to have an I.W.P.A. membership and use I.W.P.A. weight pull rules which include having an I.W.P.A. certified and approved judge.

A sanctioning application must be filled out by the organizer and delivered into the hands of the I.W.P.A. sanctioning director no later than the 15th of the month preceding the month in which the event is to take place, provided the event is scheduled between the 15th through the end of any given month. Pulls scheduled from the 1st through the 14th of any month must be received no later than the 15th of the month two months prior to the weight pull event. For example, an event scheduled for December 7th must be received no later than October 15th, an event scheduled for December 28th must be received no later than November 15th. **No exceptions to this rule will be made!!** It is the organizer's responsibility to ascertain if this application has been received by the Sanctioning Director.

Newsletter pull calendar information is taken from the sanctioning application; therefore, ALL questions must be answered. It may be considered false advertising for any organizer to falsify or fail to follow the information provided on the sanctioning request. False advertising will be grounds for placing the organizer on probationary sanctioning status.

The following list of information from your weight pull must be sent to the Sanctioning Director with a postmark no later than 5 days after the last day of your pull:

1. Weight Pull finish report
2. Organizer's report
3. Financial report with ALL monies due the IWPA for the \$5.00 per dog fee. For pulls held in Canada \$5.00 are payable in U.S. funds only. (Motion 6/07)
4. All regular and provisional membership monies received at your pull with completed membership forms must be sent to the Membership Director with a postmark no later than 5 days after the last day of your pull. New members are to be given the membership receipt included in your packet as proof of membership until their card is sent to them.
5. Send Judge's Reports to the Judge Chairperson
(The penalty for failure to meet the 5 day postmark requirement will result in a fine of not less than \$20.00 and \$5.00 per day for each day after 6 days that the pull results are not postmarked. Failure to pay a fine may result in loss of sanctioning and/or points). **Exception—Organizers of pulls held the last two weeks of the season are required to submit finish reports to the sanctioning director and FAX or OVERNIGHT their finish report, finance report, and organizer report to the statistician within one working day. (motion 5/98)**

Any grievances by an organizer or judge should be in writing, postmarked no later than 72 hours after the end of the weight pull event, and sent to the Sanctioning Director who will present the written grievance(s) to the I.W.P.A. Board of Directors *within two weeks of the receipt of the grievance*, for deliberation.

Sanctioning applications that do not include the sanctioning fees will not be accepted. Exception—When faxing application a copy of the check/money order for sanctioning fees must be faxed with the application. The original application and check/money order for sanctioning fees must be postmarked within one working day of the fax. The original application and payment for sanctioning fees must be received by the sanctioning director no less than one week prior to the event or the sanctioning may be canceled.

Organizers of events which have had sanctioning suspended after the pull will be required to mail a reimbursement to all entrants of the \$5.00 per dog fee. This reimbursement must be mailed within 72 hours of the receipt of written notice by the Sanctioning Director of suspended sanctioning. (Failure to reimburse funds when sanctioning has been suspended may mean loss of future sanctioning of event by the organizer)

The Board of Directors may not make a decision on sanctioning a pull but will make a decision regarding any grievance filed in regard to sanctioning.

If the Sanctioning on a pull is refused or the sanctioning is withdrawn from a pull, the sanctioning director will notify the organizer in writing within 2 days. A phone call or fax is a courtesy but the "in writing" is a requirement.

Cancellations of a pull will be accepted with no penalty as long as there is ample time to report the cancellation in the newsletter with the same deadlines as for sanctioning a pull. If these deadlines are not met, the organizer shall (at their own expense) send out postcards to all members to notify them of the cancellation. If this is not one, an organizer may be subject to loss of sanctioning fees. There will be no provisions for "Rain Dates". I have read and understand the above rules regarding sanctioning.

When your dog has achieved the required number of pulls for a degree (at an IWPA Sanctioned or IWPA Approved pull) and you have completed the application forms for each pull, send the forms and \$10 for each certificate requested to the Working Dog Chairperson, after September 1 in the following program year. Your certificate will be mailed to the address on the application form. Please complete all blanks on the forms to aid in the processing of the certificates. All pulls required for a certificate must be achieved in no more than two consecutive program years. The program year is from September 1 to August 31 the following year.

Requirements for Certificates

Snow

1. IWPA Working Dog: the dog must pull 5 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on snow.
2. IWPA Working Dog Excellent: the dog must pull 10 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on snow.
3. IWPA Working Dog Superior: the dog must pull 15 times its own body weight in 3 different pulls on snow.

Wheels

1. IWPA Working Dog: the dog must pull 12 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on wheels.
2. IWPA Working Dog Excellent: the dog must pull 18 times its own body weight in 4 different pulls on wheels.
3. IWPA Working Dog Superior: the dog must pull 23 times its own body weight in 3 different pulls on wheels.

Can dogs be trained to detect epileptic Seizures?

Maybe, experts say.

Deb Dalziel is a scientific researcher, and like most scientist, she tends to be pretty skeptical of theories that have not been proven conclusively.

She was intrigued by the popularly held notion that certain dogs have an ability to detect epileptic seizures before the seizures are evident to humans. An animal lover, dog trainer, and former veterinary technician, Ms Dalziel found it touching, even, to think that dogs could be their owner's saviors, and the was why she has been investigation the theory for University of Florida's veterinary program.

But, she didn't personally *believe* in the theory-not until she saw a "seizure alert" dog spring to assistance, right before her very eyes.

At a conference held by the Delta Society, an organization promoting the health benefits animals have for people, Ms. Dalziel was having a conversation with a woman with epilepsy. The women showed no signs of an impending seizure, but suddenly, her dog began action strangely, "staring at her intently, engrossed, pushing up against her" Ms. Dalziel said.

Sure enough, within moments, the woman "backed up against the wall

and slid down, and got dizzy," she said. The dog stood over the woman, protection her, for the duration of the episode.

And then was when Ms. Dalziel became convinced that seizure-alert dogs do exist. But from there, the questions multiplied; how do the animals detect seizures? Are dogs possessing certain characteristics better at detection them than others? And finally; can dogs be trained to use this ability? This last question in particular has proven to be especially difficult.

The scent of a seizure

Since most, if not all, of the evidence that dogs can alert their owners to an impending seizure is anecdotal, not much is know about how canines sense a seizure's onset. It has been hypothesized that dogs pick up on electrical cures; other theories suggest that dogs smell a particular odor, or are able to notice subtle visual changes that people fail to observe.

Dr. Roger Reep, a physiological sciences professor at the University of Florida who worked with Ms. Dalziel on the study of seizure-alert dogs for

the veterinary school, said that of all the theories, it is most plausible that some dogs can smell a seizure coming.

"Dogs are incredibly better at olfactory detection than we are, and in some reports, the olfactory odor of a seizure rises to the threshold of human detection," Dr. Reep said.



He added that patients with epilepsy have reported that

their dogs were able to detect seizures from other rooms in the house-behavior that could not, of course, depend upon visual or electrical cues.

As a species, canines are know for their keen sense of smell. But judging from the anecdotal evidence, only a very small percentage of them respond to this "seizure odor" that humans generally do not detect.

As it turns out, the ability to alert humans to a seizure is about to occur may have less to do with sense and more to do with sensibility.

The right "personality"

The University of Florida study con-

ducted by Ms. Dalziel and Dr. Reep surveyed a pool of patients and experiencing at least one epileptic seizure per month. Of the pool, 30 owned dogs, and five percent of these 30 individuals “reliably” reported that their dogs demonstrated distinct behavior signifying the onset of a seizure.

“They reported defined and unusual behavior that the dog didn’t usually exhibit,” De. Reep explained.

Although no relationship was identified between breed, sex, or age, Dr. Reep’s and Ms. Dalziel’s study found town factors to be consistent in all the dogs reported to have alerting behavior; a close bond with the owner, and an “alert” disposition.

Micheal Goehring, executive program director of the Great Plains Assistance Dogs Foundation in Jud, North Dakota, which trains about two seizure alert dogs per year, agrees that dogs need to have a temperament conducive to alerting.

“Every dog can alert, but not every dog cares to,” he said. “They all detect seizures, but not all respond appropriately.

A very “independent” dog, Mr. Goehring said, “may pick up on a seizure, but won’t feel any innate obligation towards helping the person. “ In contrast, “ a upper-submissive dogs will react very dramatically by stressing and panting, but they are doing that out of concern for themselves, and we don’t want a dog to feel stress every time there’s a seizure,” he said.

Dogs that have a “middle-of-the-road cool temperament” make the best alert dogs, Mr. Goehring explained, and Great Plains Assistance runs extensive behavior tests to ensure a clam demeanor before accepting an animal into its training program.

One test is to place the dog, unleashed, in a room with a trainer, and introduce a noise from outside the room. A dog with the appropriate personality will “ go part-way towards the directions of the sound

and then check back with the trainer, pawing gestures, showing a natural desire to include us in what he’s picked up on,” Mr. Goehring said.

But even if there is a small population of dogs that have the “right” personality, can they necessarily be trained to alert their owners to the onset of a seizure? The answer isn’t clear.

Questioning the trainers

Mr. Goehring is very selective about which dogs he trains for patients with epilepsy. But because, as he admits, there is no hard evidence presently available proving that dogs can be trained to alert, some experts are skeptical about endorsing the work that seizure-alert trainers do so.



Neither the Epilepsy Foundation nor the Epilepsy Institute—the two major American organizations devoted to epilepsy treatment and research—recommend that patients see these dogs for training. In a press statement, the Epilepsy Foundation said that “since there is currently no way of knowing what kind of training is needed to develop these skills in dogs, nor even whether is possible to do so, the Epilepsy Foundation suggest that people should be cautious about purchasing ‘seizure dogs.’”

And Andrea Azrzt, assistant director of the Epilepsy Institute, which did a study on this issue through video-monitoring several years ago, conceded that “some dogs may be naturally aware, or born with this ability.”

Even some seizure assistance dog trainers question whether dogs can be trained to alert.

Michael Sapp, chief operation officer of Paws with a Cause, a program that places assistance dogs nationally, said that dogs that can detect seizures before their obvious owners are “few and far between.”

Therefore, Paws with a Cause does not claim to train seizure-alert dogs— instead,

it offers “seizure-repose” dogs, or dogs trained to assist epilepsy patients while they are having seizures. Most assistance dog programs of similar services.

Mr. Sapp did say that a small percentage of Paws’ response dogs demonstrated the ability to detect seizures. Primarily, through, “we have dogs that push life-alert buttons to call the hospitals or neighbors, and dogs that can pick up a cordless phone and bring it to the person having a seizure,” he explained.

A helping “paw” in a time of need

Even if there is no hard evidence that dogs can be trained to alert their owners to a seizure onset, the important thing to remember, said Susan Duncan of the Delta Society, is that “having the dog there” during the seizure has its benefits.

“The dog becomes a constant the can be relied upon regardless of where a person is or whether other people are available to be with the person,” she said.

Dogs that do appear to have the ability to alert can help their owner to sit or lie down so they can remain safe during the seizure. But “seizure response” dogs can do something for patients with epilepsy that are also very valuable, Ms. Duncan said.

“They can get help, help the person to get up safely after the seizure, and present unnecessary interference from people who do not know how to respond,” she explained. “The claim presence of the dog can assure others that the person’s seizure is not an unexpected event.”

Added Ms. Duncan, who has multiple sclerosis and has experienced seizures herself, “It can be comforting for the person to see the familiar dog after the seizure has taken place.”

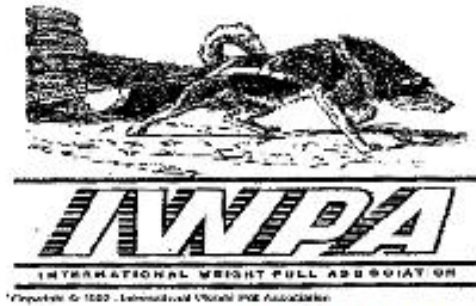

Note: Renewing Judges **must sign and return this form** (with the proper fee) stating that you have read and understand the following changes in the IWPA Standing rules and Rule booklet that have been placed in effect at the board meeting on June 5, 2010. This also includes the **Judges Code of Conduct** that was adopted by the board in 2002.

International Weight Pull Association Judge Code of Conduct (Ethics and Authority)

1. You must both possess and project an unwavering air of integrity and ethical behavior that protects the reputation of IWPA pull events as fair and well-judged. With common sense, judges can easily avoid situations, which might raise ethical questions. A judge should avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety in all activities.

2. Judges are presumed to be honest, competent and dedicated. Nevertheless, it is all too easy to find yourself in uncomfortable or even inappropriate situations. Guidelines cannot cover every situation, but they can help you avoid improprieties or perceived improprieties. A judge should perform the duties impartially and diligently. ("A judge shall disqualify himself or herself in a

proceeding in which the judge's impartiality might reasonably be questioned, including but not limited to instances in which the judge has a personal bias or prejudice concerning a party...")

3. You Are in Charge: As the Chief Judge, you have full authority over all persons in the event. With this authority comes the responsibility to be thoughtful and considerate. Be as systematic in your procedure from dog to dog and weight class to weight class as conditions permit.

4. You should avoid theatrical movements or making inappropriate comments to competitors. Be polite, but generally limit your conversation with competitors to instructions that are in accordance with the IWPA rules.

5. The Judge may use whatever reasonable procedures he/she deems necessary to evaluate each dog's performance in an effective and efficient manner. The same procedures will be used to Judge each dog in a class. By entering any weight pull, the owner and handler of any dog agree to accept the decision of the Judge as final. The decision of a Judge is the responsibility of the Judge and not that of the IWPA.

6. IWPA events are intended to be family-oriented recreation for dog lovers and their dogs. Accordingly, IWPA expects the highest standard of conduct at all events.

Rule Changes for 2010-2011

Section 5 C #14 Revision

Will read; "14. The use of whips, noisemakers, muzzles, pinch collars or related aids shall not be permitted at any time during an *IWPA* event. Throwing of items while the dog is in pulling shut is considered baiting. No food, treats or bait/baiting shall be used from the time the dogs class begins until the dog is eliminated from competition and removed from the pull area. Handlers shall not have food or bait on their person during the competition."

Section 4 A #2 Clarification

All dogs must be at least (1) year of age. Dogs may not be more than 12 years of age at the beginning of the season to compete in any IWPA event.

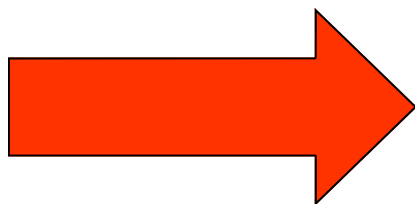
