

General Membership Meeting—Spokane, WA May 5th, 2017

President George Ferrari called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM.

Sean Hammell brought up the topic if a Haltie/Gentile Leader collar as an approved collar. There was discussion about it being a means of controlling the dog. Also, this specific collar was once listed in the pulling rules booklet. Secretary Robbie Reed will need to research to find when it was removed out of the pulling rules booklet.

Jean Wilson inquired if the fence past the finish line was "hot". The answer is no; it is not hot such as between the start and finish lines. This question was brought up because she had an incident during the season where a handler had used the fence on the handler side of the finish line to assist them getting up. She wanted to insure the rule was interpreted correctly.

Mary Hernandez inquired about keeping track of the 4th and 5th place dogs and how that is interpreted if you have beaten the top 3 finishers of the class at the time the dog beat them; not the finish order at the end of the season. It was explained this applies for the final results and medal recipients; not during the middle of middle season.

Wendy Leister inquired if the Mid-East District is up for the Championship bid for next season (2017-2018). Todd Sheehan expressed it is unfair for the East District to only get to submit a bid every (4) 6 years. It was brought up how the "committee" researched the number of dogs in attendance at Championships in in west, east and mid areas of the US and Canada. It was determined the years in the middle of the country allow for more pullers to participate as members do not have to travel clear across the US and Canada to compete.

Donna Daymude suggested a time frame be discussed by the board, for members to insure statistics are updated in a timely manner with name corrections made immediately, not at the end of the season.

Sean Hammell brought up about electronic payments to the IWPA. Treasurer Cheryl Martin advised she has obtained an FEIN number and we should be able to accept payments this fall for the 2017-2018 season via PayPal.

Jean Wilson expressed her thanks to the Board for the definition of the handicap rule that the Board of Directors established during the Board Meeting in 2016. This clarification has been extremely helpful.

Jennifer Berning inquired why nominations for the Board of Directors is not followed as written in the By-Laws. She explained a new member wouldn't know they could submit a letter of intent to run unless this was told to them. Also board positions and committee positions do not all have job descriptions.

Party Animal Dog Food Recall of April 2017

April 17, 2017 — Party Animal, Inc. <u>has announced it is recalling</u> specific lots of two varieties of its Cocolicious canned dog foods because they have each tested positive for the euthanasia drug, **pentobarbital**.



What's Being Recalled?

The following products are affected by the recall:

Cocolicious Beef and Turkey

Size: 12 ounce cans Lot Number: 0136E15204 04 Best By Date: July 2019

Cocolicious Chicken and Beef
Size: 12 ounce cans

Lot Number: 0134E15 237 13 Best By Date: August 2019

What Caused the Recall?

According to a statement posted on the company's website and its Facebook page:

The safety of pets is and always will be our first priority. We sincerely regret the reports of the discomfort experienced by the pet who consumed this food. As pet parents ourselves, we take this matter seriously.

On April 13, a retailer in Texas notified us that their customer had presented samples of our Cocolicious Beef and Turkey Lot #0136E15204 04 and Cocolicious Chicken and Beef Lot #0134E15 237 13 to a testing lab, and that the results had tested positive for pentobarbital.

We have requested those results.

When we were notified, we immediately tracked the lot numbers of the food in question and determined that the food had been manufactured and distributed in 2015.

We then contacted the two probable retailers that had sold the customer the food and asked them to isolate all remaining cans from these lots.

We also requested that the retailers send all of the cans from those lots to us so that we can forward them on to an accredited independent laboratory for independent testing.

We expect to receive the results in 7 to 10 days.

We first saw the formal report from the lab at Texas A&M regarding the customer's samples, today, April 17.

Out of an abundance of caution, we are retrieving the remainder of these two lots nationwide.

We are working with our distributors and retailers to determine if any additional beef-flavored products manufactured during this 2015 production period remain on shelves and, if so, to retrieve them from shelves, immediately, as well.

Smallbatch Dog and Cat Food Recall of May 2017

May 5, 2017 — Smallbatch Pets Inc. of Portland, OR, is voluntarily recalling two lots of its Smallbatch frozen chicken blend for dogs and cats due to the potential to be contaminated with **Salmonella**.



About Salmonella
