It may be considered false advertising for any organizer to falsify or fail to follow the information provided in the sanctioning request. False advertising will be grounds for placing organizer on probationary sanctioning status.

In order for your pull to count for points:

The following list of information from your weight pull must be sent to the **Sanctioning Director** with a postmark of **no later than 7 days** after the last day of your pull;

1. Weight Pull finish results

- 3. Financial report with all money due the IWPA (\$5.00/dog for both IWPA and provisional members)

The following reports are to be sent to the **Judge's Chair** postmark of **no later than 7 days** after the last day of your pull; Judge's Report & Handler Meeting Registration.

Any infractions of the above stated conditions, or IWPA Weight Pull rules, shall constitute grounds for suspension of sanctioning, or probationary status. Loss of sanctioning constitutes loss of insurance. Sanctioning may be withheld up to 1 week prior to the event. It will be the responsibility of the organizer to notify all IWPA members of cancellation due to loss of sanctioning or conditions beyond the organizers control.

Any grievances by the organizer or judge should be in writing and postmarked no later than 72 hours after the end of the weight pull event and sent to the sanctioning director who will present the written grievances to the IWPA board of directors for deliberation.
